1. Issue emergent notice to the respondent both on the main matter as well as on the question of limitation by Speed Post with A.D. returnable within two weeks, requisites for which shall be filed within three working days.

In addition to taking usual steps, appellant is permitted to serve copy of the appeal papers on the learned counsel, who represented the respondent-employee before the learned Single Judge in the writ petition.

The contention of learned counsel appearing for the appellant that interim order needs to be granted cannot be exceeded to at this stage, since law is settled by the Apex Court to the effect that without condoning delay no orders can be granted in matters other than matrimonial.



It is open to the appellant to mention before the Contempt Court that this appeal is pending and emergent notice is ordered.
