01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Parties.
2. By means of this application, the Petitioner seeks the intervention of this Court for a direction to the Opposite Party No.3 to register the complaint as FIR and to proceed with the investigation in accordance with law.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, in course of the hearing in the application submitted that, for the redressal of her grievance, the Petitioner had lodged a complaint before the O.I.C., Choudakulat, Outpost on 23.10.2025. As no action was initiated on the complaint, the Petitioner approached the Superintendent of Police, Kendrapara, by filing another complaint dated 29.11.2025, but of no avail.



4. In view of the aforesaid submissions of the learned counsel for the Petitioner, Opposite Party No.3 i.e. the IIC, Pattamundai P.S., is directed to examine the complaint and in the event, a cognizable offence is made out from the complaint, he shall register the same and proceed with the investigation in accordance with law.

5. Accordingly, the CRLMP stands disposed of.
