- 1.** This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
- 2.** Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties.
- 3.** The present Writ Petition has been filed *inter alia* with the following prayer:-

*"It is, therefore, prayed before the Hon'ble Court to
allow the petition,*

AND

- (i) *Further be pleased to issue Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ(s) to direct to the O.P. No.4, the Superintending Engineer, Rural works Division, Baripada, Mayurbhanj, to prepare DLR Gradation list including the name of the Petitioner engaged on 10.06.2013 after the cut-off date i.e.12.04.1993, who have not yet been regularized in the Regular Establishment,*



AND

- (ii) *Further, be pleased to pass any other Writ(s)/order(s)/direction(s) as deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case,*

AND

- (iii) *For this act of kindness, the petitioners, as in duty bound, shall ever pray.”*

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the Petitioner state that highlighting his grievances, the Petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.4 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned Counsel for the State has no objection.

5. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties and after going through the records, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the Writ Petition directing Opposite Party No.4 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-6 in accordance with law within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of production of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
