03. 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. The Petitioners are seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with G.R. Case No.833 of 2025 pending in the Court of learned SDJM, Kuchinda arising out of Kuchinda P.S. Case No.321 of 2025 for commission of offence punishable under Sections 318(4)/336(3)/338/340(2)/3(5) of BNS.

3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Petitioners that since the allegation is making application for mutation citing that the LRs are not alive, custodial interrogation of the Petitioners is unwarranted.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail.



5. Taking into account the nature of allegations, it is directed that on surrendering within three weeks hence and moving for bail, the Petitioners shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper subject to verification of criminal antecedent of similar nature.

6. If it comes to the fore that the Petitioners have any such criminal antecedent, this order shall not be given effect to.

7. It is needless to state that the Petitioners shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

8. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of. U.C.C. as per rules.
