1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. On the prayer of the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the defect pointed out by the Stamp Reporter is ignored.
 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner. Perused the CMP application.
 4. By filing the present CMP application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, the Plaintiff in C.S. No.2580 of 2025 has approached this Court by filing the present application for a direction to the learned Civil Judge, Senior Division, Bhubaneswar for an early disposal of the I.A. filed under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 of the CPC in the abovenoted suit.
 5. Learned counsel for the Petitioner, at the outset, contended that the Petitioner, as a plaintiff, filed the abovenoted suit for specific performance of contract along with an I.A. under Order 39 Rule 1 &



2 of the CPC. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at this juncture contended that although there is urgency, and accordingly an application has been filed for injunctive relief, the same has not yet been taken up despite passing several orders in the meantime.

6. Taking into consideration the aforesaid submission, this Court deems it proper to dispose of the present CMP application by granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the learned trial court for early disposal of the I.A. application. In such eventuality, the learned trial court shall do well to consider the I.A. application after providing opportunity to both sides and dispose of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of communication of a copy of today's order.

7. With the aforesaid observation and direction, the CMP application stands disposed of.
