- 01.** 1. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
2. The Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with C.T. Case No.1922 of 2025 pending on the file of learned JMFC, Soro, arising out of Soro P.S. Case No.995 of 2025 for commission of offences punishable under Sections 4, 5 and 6 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908.
3. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for pre-arrest bail.
4. Taking into account the nature of allegations and the punishment prescribed, this Court directs that on surrendering within three weeks hence and



moving for bail, the Petitioner shall be released on bail by the learned Court in seisin on such terms as deemed just and proper.

5. Additionally, it is directed that the Petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Police Station once a week on such date and time to be fixed by the learned Court in seisin till submission of final form. Certification of such appearance shall be submitted to the learned Court in seisin.

6. It is needless to state that the Petitioner shall cooperate with the ongoing investigation.

7. Accordingly, the ABLAPL stands disposed of.
