01. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This Contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 30.11.2022 passed in W.P.(C) No.20215 of 2022 and order dated 12.12.2023 passed in CONTC No.9498 of 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the petitioner approached this Court in W.P.(C) No.20215 of 2022 with a prayer for expeditious disposal of Lease Case No.1 of 2009 pending before the opposite party no.4, Tahasildar, Khurda, this Court vide order dated 30.11.2022 disposed of the writ petition directing the opposite party No.4 to deal with and dispose of the lease case within two months from the communication



of the order. In spite of the communication of the order, since within the stipulated time, the opposite party no.4 did not dispose of the lease case, Contempt petition No.9498 of 2023 was filed which was also disposed of on 12.12.2023 giving time for three months to the opposite parties from the date of communication of the order to comply the order dated 30.11.2022 passed in W.P.(C) No.20215 and in spite of such orders of this Court, the lease case has not yet been disposed of.

Learned counsel for the State seeks two weeks' time to obtain instruction about the status of lease case No.1 of 2009 pending before the opposite parties-Contemnors.
