1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with T.R. Case No.04 of 2025 pending in the file of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Nabarangpur arising out of Kosagumuda P.S. Case No.188 of 2025 on the grounds stated.
3. The petitioner is alleged of being in possession of contraband Ganja. The FIR as at Annexure-1 reveals that the seizure of Ganja was of 6 Kg 014 grams and it was from the house of the petitioner. Such recovery is admittedly in respect of less than commercial quantity of contraband Ganja. On being asked, whether the petitioner is having any antecedent, learned counsel appearing for him submits that he has no instructions. Recorded the objection of the State. The petitioner is a lady aged about 53 years and she is the sole accused.



Considering the above facts and submissions of learned counsels for the respective parties, this Court instead of entertaining plea of pre-arrest bail is in favour of and directing the petitioner to surrender before the learned court below for being released with suitable conditions.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioner surrenders before the court of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Nabarangpur within fortnight from today, it is directed that she shall be released on bail in connection with T.R. Case No.04 of 2025 corresponding to Kosagumuda P.S. Case No.188 of 2025 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case subject to absence of similar antecedent.
