03. 1. Perused the instructions dated 10.02.2026 of the I.I.C., Bansda Police Station from it is apparent that even though the accused Gouri Majhi has not complied with the order of this Court passed on 25.11.2025 in ABLAPL No. 13241 of 2025, no steps have been taken by the I.O./I.I.C., Bansada Police Station for her arrest.

2. Paragraph-6 of the instruction is held as follows:-

“6. It is a fact that the alleged aced Gouri Maihi filed an anticipatory bail before the Hon’ble High Court, Orissa vide ABLAPL No 13241 of 2025 in which Hon’ble Court pleased to pass orders on 25.11.2025 that Gouri Majhi would surrender before the Hon’ble Court of JMFC, Chandbali within one month and is at liberty to move the higher forum for bail in the



second hour in the event of rejection of the bail application by her. But on verification the accused Gouri Majhi has not surrendered in the court of law in the stipulated time. On conducting search, she was found absent in her house and hide herself somewhere else. Sincere steps are being taken for early arrest of the said accused Gouri Majhi in this case.”

3. Mr. Parsuram Panda, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that even though information has been provided to the I.I.C., Bansada Police Station regarding the whereabouts of the accused persons Gouri Majhi, Babuli Majhi and Sipun Majhi and even though there is no order of any Court protecting them for arrest, the I.I.C., Bansada Police Station has not taken any steps to arrest them.

4. List this case on 25.02.2026 awaiting instructions regarding steps taken in the investigation.
