1. Issue notice.

5. Heard Mr. A. Mishra, learned counsel for the Petitioner.

6. In the present interim application, the Petitioners seek stay operation of the order under Annexure-5 series, i.e. the orders dated 13.08.2025, 08.09.2025 and order dated 25.09.2025 of the



Assistant Commissioner of Endowments, Bhubaneswar. As seen from those orders, particularly order dated 13.08.2025, the Assistant Commissioner of Endowments formed the Non-hereditary Trust Board in respect of Shree Sidheswari Thakurani@Kali Thakurani, At/PO-Kapila Prasad, in the district of Khurda. Such order dated 13.08.2025 being a statutory order passed under Section 27 of the Odisha Hindu Religious Endowments Act, 1951, I am not inclined to stay operation of the same and other two consequential orders of the authority at the instance of present Petitioners, who are the private persons.

7. Accordingly, the I.A. is dismissed.
