1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.
2. Heard Mr. Dey, learned counsel for the petitioners.
3. Instant writ petition is filed by the petitioners challenging the impugned orders under Annexure-5 passed in CS No.211 of 2023 by learned Senior Civil Judge, Balangir.
4. Mr. Dey, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the facts sought to be incorporated concerning the subject matter in dispute was allowed by learned court below despite an objection as per Annexure-4. Considering the submission as above, challenge to the order of amendment as at Annexure-5, the Court is inclined to consider the response of the opposite parties and hence, it is ordered.
5. Notice to the opposite party by Registered Post with AD returnable at an early date and for the said purpose, requisites shall be



filed by Mr. Day, learned counsel for petitioners within seven days from today.
