1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. The appellant-petitioner has filed IA No.2849 of 2025 under Rule-22(2) of the Orissa Motor Vehicles (Accident Claims Tribunal) Rules, 1960 (in short, "the Rules") for exemption from paying of Court fees for time being.
4. Heard learned counsel for the appellant and perused the record.
5. After hearing learned counsel for the appellant and on going through the averments of the IA, the prayer of the appellant for exemption of payment of Court fees for the time being stands allowed till disposal of this appeal. It is, however, made clear that the appellant shall be liable to pay the Court fees as



exempted by this order after disposal of the appeal. Accordingly, the IA No.2849 of 2025 stands disposed of.
