10. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.S.C. Perused the case record.

Learned A.S.C. submitted that the appropriate authority will file a writ appeal.

On the other hand, Mr. Acharya, learned counsel for the decree holder vehemently opposed the submission of the learned A.S.C. He further clarified that the decree holder is a senior citizen and widow. The concerned government authorities are harassing the family of decree holder since the order of Hon'ble Court 08.05.2023 passed in WPC(OAC) No.1442 of 2011.

The Director, Elementary Education, Bhubaneswar and Block Education Officer, Angul are directed to comply with the order of Hon'ble Court on 08.05.2023 within two weeks.
