14. Heard Mr. Acharya, learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.S.C. Perused the case records and disposed of order of Hon'ble Court dated 08.05.2023 passed in WP(C) (OAC) 1442 of 2011.

Vide order dated 12.11.2025, O.P. No.3 was directed to appear personally today for clarifications regarding non-compliance of the Hon'ble Court's order. Today, Block Education Officer, Angul remained personally present before the Lawzima Court. The Director, Elementary Education Shri Balamakunda Bhuyan has filed show cause affidavit through mentioning therein that Government has filed Writ Appeal No.1917 of 2025 challenging the order dated 08.05.2023. A copy of show cause affidavit dated 10.12.2025 be served on the learned counsel for the petitioner. The learned A.S.C. submitted to grant some

time for obtaining order from the court in WA No. 1917 of 2025. On the other hand, Mr. Acharya vehemently opposed the submission of learned A.S.C. Heard both sides considering the submission of the learned A.S.C. personal appearance of the Block Education Officer is dispensed with and filing of the affidavit, for the time being.

Put up this case on 21.01.2026. The concerned opposite parties are directed to comply with the order of Hon'ble Court passed on 08.05.2023 or obtain stay order in Writ appeal. Otherwise, this Executing Court will issue appropriate directions as per Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
