01. 1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Considering the urgency of the matter that the Petitioners apprehend their arrest and that the Courts are not functioning during the winter vacation, the matter is taken up directly without remanding the matter to the jurisdictional Sessions Court.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners as well as learned Standing Counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Party. Perused the bail application as well as the documents annexed thereto.
4. The present application has been filed under Section 482 of B.N.S.S., 2023 by the Petitioners seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Narayanpatna P.S. Case No.0055 of 2025, corresponding to G.R. Case No.225 of 2025, pending in the court of learned J.M.F.C., Laxmipur, registered for alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 296/ 115(2)/ 294/ 351(2)/ 49/ 76/3(5) of B.N.S. 2023 read with Section 67(A) of the Information



Technology Act, 2000.

5. Keeping in view the principle laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Satender Kumar Antil - vrs.- Central Bureau of Investigation & Another***, reported in ***(2022) 10 SCC 51***, this Court directs that in the event the Petitioners surrender before the court in seisin over the matter within a period of three weeks from today and moves an application for bail, the court in seisin over the matter shall release them on bail in connection with the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as it may deem just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case, but subject to verification of criminal antecedent of the Petitioners. In the event it is found by the court below that the Petitioners are having any criminal antecedent, then this order shall not be given effect to. Violation of any of the terms and conditions shall entail cancellation of bail.

6. Accordingly, the ABLAPL is disposed of.
