1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant contempt petition is filed by the petitioner for non-compliance of the Court's order in IA No.17364 of 2023 arising out W.P.(C) No.22008 of 2023.
3. It is submitted by Ms. Pattanaik, learned counsel for the petitioner that the Court's order dated 27th July, 2023 W.P.(C) No.22008 of 2023 has not been complied with and consequential order in the IA. In so far as the demarcation is concerned, it has been held as per the compliance affidavit is filed. In IA No.17364 of 2023, State was directed to dispose of the encroachment proceedings initiated against the petitioners in W.P.(C) No.22008 of 2023. According to Ms. Pattanaik, learned counsel for the petitioner, there has been no full compliance of the order with the removal of encroachment. Since, there is a demarcation held in the meantime and compliance of the Court's order, in view of the claim of the



petitioner that the eviction with the demolition has not taken place, the contempt petition stands disposed of with the direction to opposite party No.2 to accomplish the same as soon as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
