18. Learned counsel for both the sides are present.

Perused the execution petition case record and disposed of order dated 20.02.2023 passed in W.P(C) (OAC) No.3610 of 2013.

Upon going through the affidavit dated 19.11.2025 filed by the District Education Officer, Mayurbhanj it reveals that the State Government has preferred writ appeal bearing number W.A. No.2779 of 2024 challenging the order passed in WP(C)(OAC) No. 3610 of 2013. It is also evident from the said affidavit that the order passed by the Hon'ble Court has not been complied with.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the direction of the Hon'ble Court is categorically clear in granting all retirement benefits to the petitioner with effect from 1st June, 1997 within 6

months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Although more than 3 years have been elapsed the said order was not complied with rather the State is sitting ideally over the issue by filing a writ appeal and there is nothing in the affidavit to show that the order passed by the Hon'ble Court in WP(C)(OAC) No. 3610 of 2013 was stayed in the writ appeal.

Heard both sides. Perused the case record and it reveals that despite a direction by the Hon'ble Court in WP(C)(OAC) No. 3610 of 2013 passed on 20.02.2023 the same was not executed. Though writ appeal was filed the order passed in WP(C)(OAC) No. 3610 of 2013 has not been stayed. This is an execution petition of the year 2024 and despite repeated directions compliance has not been made. In view of the above, it is felt proper that the order of the Hon'ble Court be executed through the process of the Court as per the provisions laid down in C.P.C. The execution petition reveals that the petitioner wants to execute the order of the Hon'ble Court through the mode of attachment and sale of the property of the opposite parties. In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to submit the list of property of the erring officers which are to be attached for execution of the Hon'ble Court's order dated 20.02.2023.

Put up this matter on 15.07.2026 for submission of the list of the property of the O.Ps. for attachment.
