1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
2. Heard learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner as well as learned counsel appearing for the State-Opposite Parties. Perused the records.
3. On perusal of the writ application it appears that the Petitioner has approached this Court by filing the present writ application thereby challenging order passed under the O.G.L.S. Act by the authorities under Annexure-3 series to the writ application. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that although no formal notice of eviction has been issued by the authorities under the O.G.L.S. authorities, however, the authorities are making public announcement in the locality to the effect that the Petitioner and similarly situated other persons shall be evicted by the 30.12.2024.



4. Learned counsel for the State on the other hand submitted that there is no formal notice of eviction.

5. Taking into account the aforesaid facts, it is directed that two extra copies of the brief be served on learned counsel for the State, who shall obtained instructions in the matter.

6. List this matter before the appropriate assigned bench on 03.01.2025.
