1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with G.R. Case No.493 of 2019 pending in the file of learned J.M.F.C., Salepur arising out of Salepur P.S. Case No. 168 dated 12th July, 2019 on the grounds stated.
3. A case under Section 307 IPC is registered. The alleged incident is narrated in the FIR as at Annexure-1. It is alleged that the assault was by means of an iron rod. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the informant and his friend have not received any serious injury, as a result of the mischief committed by the petitioner. As further submitted, the chargesheet is filed in the meantime. A copy of the chargesheet is produced in the Court itself. Recording the submissions as above as to absence of any grievous injury and objection of the



State, this Court is inclined to direct the petitioner to surrender before the learned court below for being released on bail subject to absence of criminal antecedent of similar nature and any such serious injury received by the victim of the assault.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioner surrenders before the court of learned J.M.F.C., Salepur within fortnight from today, it is directed that he shall be released on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.493 of 2019 corresponding to Salepur P.S. Case No.168 dated 12th July, 2019 on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) with one solvent surety for the like amount with such other conditions imposed as deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.
