1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Mode.
2. On perusal of the order sheet, it appears on 03.07.2026, on the request of learned counsel for the Contemnor, they were granted time to take steps for early listing of the writ appeal and to obtain an interim order.
3. Despite such time being granted, the Opposite Party-Contemnor could not get the matter listed or produced a copy of the interim order from the Appellate Division Bench.
4. Considering the fact that the order was passed more than one year ago, the Opposite Party-Contemnor shall direct to implement the order provisionally subject to the outcome of the writ appeal.



5. In such view of the matter, on the request of learned counsel for the Contemnor, he is granted four weeks' time, as a last chance. In the event the Opposite Party-Contemnor fails to implement the order subject to the outcome of the writ appeal, the Opposite Party-Contemnor shall be asked to appear before this court in person and explain as to why she shall not be proceeded against under the Contempt of Court's Act for her wilful and deliberate violation of this Court's order.

6. List this matter on 18.09.2026.

7. It is further made clear that in the event there are no legal impediments in disbursing the unutilised leave salary in favour of the Petitioner, the Opposite Party-Contemnor shall take immediate steps for sanction and disbursal of such unutilized leave salary in favour of the Petitioner by the next date.
