- 01.** **1.** Heard Mr. K.P.Mishra, learned senior advocate appears in virtual mode and address arguments.
- 2.** Petitioners are aggrieved by the non-provision of pensionary benefit to them though according to the petitioner they have worked for considerable period in the establishment under the District Rural Development Agency (D.R.D.A.), thereafter which has merged with Zilla Parishad. Learned senior counsel brings to the notice of the Court letters annexed to the petition marked as Annexure-4 series



wherein the Principal Accountant General was intimated for provision of pensionary benefit to the petitioners.

3. Issue notice along with this order to the opposite parties.

4. Learned AGA on advance copy served appears on behalf of opposite parties 1, 2, 6 and 7.

5. Learned DSGI appears along with Mr. M.K.Pati, learned CGC on behalf of opposite party no.4. Let one extra copy be served on the learned DSGI. Let four extra copies be served on the learned AGA.

6. Mr. Sudhir Kumar Patra, learned Standing Counsel appears and waives notice on behalf of opposite party no.3. Let one extra copy be served on Mr. Patra appearing for opposite party no.3-Principal Accountant General (A&E).

7. Notice to the opposite parties 5, 8 & 9 be issued by registered post/speed post with A/D. Requisites for issuance of notice be filed within five working days. Learned AGA, DSGI and learned Standing Counsel appearing for opposite parties 1, 2, 6 & 7 seek four weeks time to file counter. Accordingly, counter be filed upon serving copy thereof on the learned counsel for the petitioner. Petitioner shall have the liberty to file their rejoinder.



8. List after pleadings are complete. The other noticed opposite parties shall have the liberty to file their response on appearance. Liberty to mention.
