07. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for O.P. No.2 and learned ASC for the State are present.
3. Upon hearing from the learned counsels of both the sides, it is felt proper to dispose of this writ petition finally giving liberty to the petitioner to challenge the R.o.R. of the case land prepared in the name of the O.P. No.2 in Mutation Case No.300 of 2018 passed by the Tahasildar, Gania in the District of Nayagarh.

In case of preferring an appeal by the petitioner annexing the certified copy of this order before the Sub-Collector, Nayagarh, the Sub-Collector, Nayagarh shall entertain the same without questioning about the



limitation invoking the provisions under Section 14 of the Indian Limitation Act, 1963, as the petitioner had approached the wrong forum bonafidely by filing this writ petition and the Sub-Collector, Nayagarh shall dispose of the same on merit as per law as expeditiously as possible.

4. As such, this writ petition filed by the petitioner is disposed of finally.
