1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. Since the appellant has already filed the cheque of Rs.25,000/- towards the statutory deposit, the cheque amount be invested in the name of Registrar (Judicial) in any Nationalized Bank by opening an interest bearing account renewable from time to time.
3. Mr. S.R. Ojha, learned counsel for the appellant by filing the photocopy of the cheque together with postal receipt for sending the cheque to R1 to R4 submits that the cost has already been paid as directed by this Court. Accordingly, the delay of 200 days in preferring the appeal stands condoned. IA No. 329 of 2025 stands disposed of.
