1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid mode.
2. This is an application has been filed by the Petitioner for seeking modification of order dated 30.12.2025.
3. Learned counsel for the Petitioner at the outset contended that vide order dated 30.12.2025 this Court allowed the Petitioner to surrender and go on bail subject to the terms and condition mentioned in the order dated 30.12.2025. He further contended that this Court has imposed a condition with regard to verification of the antecedent of the Petitioner. He further submitted that it is found that the Petitioner is involved in one similar criminal antecedent.
4. Learned counsel for the State on the other hand objected to



the modification on the ground that the Petitioner is having similar antecedent. However taking into consideration the submission made by counsel appearing for the parties, order dated 30.12.2025 is modified to the extent that the learned trial Court shall now verify the antecedent and in the event it is found that the Petitioner is having more than one criminal antecedent, then this order dated 30.12.2025 shall not be given effect to.

5. In view of the aforesaid modification, the Petitioner is further directed to furnish a cash security of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand) before the learned Court in seisin over the matter, which shall be kept in any Nationalized Bank in interest bearing account initially for a period of one year which will be renewable from time to time till conclusion of trial and the same shall be abide by the final outcome of the trial of the case.

6. In view of the aforesaid modification, the time of surrender is extended by a further period of four weeks from today, but subject to depositing cost of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) in the Advocates' Welfare Fund of Orissa High Court Bar Association within fifteen days and furnishing money receipt thereof in proof of deposit.

7. Accordingly, the I.A. stands disposed of.
