1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. Mr. Mishra, learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that the matter has been entrusted to Mr. Biswal, learned Additional Standing Counsel, who is not well today. He, therefore, prays for an adjournment.
 3. Mr. Debata, learned Counsel for the Opposite Party No.1-Union submits that copy of the writ petition has not been served on him. He vehemently objects to the prayer for adjournment.
 4. It is submitted by Mr. Debata, learned Counsel that due to pendency of the writ petition, the complaint lodged by the Opposite Party No.1 is not being entertained by the authorities.



5. Let copy of the writ petition be served on Mr. Debata, learned Counsel for the Union by 27th February, 2026, if his e-mail I.D. is provided to the learned State Counsel.

6. Taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned Counsel for the parties, this Court adjourns the matter, to be listed on 25th March, 2026.

7. It is made clear that there is no interim order operating in the matter. Thus, the Competent Authority may entertain the grievance of the Opposite Party No.1-Union in accordance with law, which shall be subject to the result of the writ petition.
