1. The appellant-wife has filed this appeal on 22.12.2025 challenging the judgment and decree dated 04.04.2023 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court, Cuttack in Civil Proceeding No.43 of 2021 that was filed by the respondent-husband. By the said judgment and decree dated 04.04.2023, the CP filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13(1)(i-a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 seeking dissolution of his marriage with the appellant-wife that was solemnized on 01.03.2010 was allowed and the marriage between both the parties was dissolved.
