1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual/Physical Mode).
2. This is the bail application U/S.483 of BNSS by the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Digapahandi PS Case No.246 of 2025 corresponding to GR Case No.306 of 2025 pending in the file of learned JMFC, Digapahandi for commission of offences punishable U/Ss. 296/115(2)/118(I)/109/351(3)/3(5) of BNS, on the main allegation of attempting to the life of the injured Binaya Gouda by assaulting him with an iron road, along with co-accused persons.
3. Heard, Mr. Santosh Kumar Mahanty, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. P.Satapathy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor in the present matter and perused the record including the copy of order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in ABLAPL No. 8711 of 2025.
4. After having considered the rival submissions and taking into consideration the nature and gravity of



the offences as alleged against the petitioner vis-à-vis the accusations sought to be brought against him and regard being had to the pre trial detention of the petitioner in custody since 02.12.2025 with voluntary surrender of the petitioner and the injury sustained by the injured being stated to be simple in nature in the order passed in ABLAPL No. 8711 of 2025 and keeping in view the other circumstances on record in entirety and the bail application of the petitioner having not been considered on merit by the learned PO, OPID Court, Berhampur, this Court without expressing any view on merits admits the petitioner to bail.

5. Hence, the bail application of the petitioner stands allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-five Thousand) only with one solvent surety for the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court in seisin of the case on such terms and conditions as deem fit and proper by it.

6. Accordingly, the BLAPL stands disposed of. Issue urgent certified copy of the order as per Rules. A copy of this order be transmitted to the learned PO, OPID Court, Berhampur for information. A soft copy of this order be immediately communicated to the concerned Court, who shall afterwards communicate the same to the concerned Jail through e-mail for reference.
