1. This matter is taken up through Hybrid Arrangement (Virtual /Physical Mode).
 2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State-Opposite Parties. Perused the writ application as well as the prayer made therein.
 3. By filing the present writ application, the Petitioner seeks for a direction to the Opposite Parties to regularize the service of the Petitioner from the date of appointment by quashing the impugned order at Annexures-10 and 12 to the writ application and for a further direction to pay the pensionary as well as the consequential financial benefits as is due and admissible to the Petitioner.
