03. 1. The Appellant, namely, Pravat Kumar Moharana, by filing this application has prayed for grant of interim bail on the ground of death of his father (Brajabandhu Moharana) taking place on 23.12.2023.
3. Learned Counsel for the Appellant submits that there being no other responsible male member in the family, the presence of the Appellant at home is absolutely necessary to perform the obsequies by arranging everything. He, therefore, prays for grant of interim bail to the Appellant so that he would go to his house and

do the needful. In support of the same, he has invited our attention to the death summary issued by the Hospital at Annexure-1.

4. Learned counsel for the State submits to have received no such instruction as yet.

5. Taking into account the submissions made and on going through the averments taken in the petition as well as Annexure-1, we are inclined to grant interim bail to the Appellant, namely, Pravat Kumar Moharana till 02.01.2024 on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the learned Sessions Judge, Cuttack in S. T. Case No.17 of 2017 with further conditions that the Appellant shall not indulge himself in any criminal activity during the period of interim bail; and shall positively surrender before the Trial Court on 03.01.2024.

6. The I.A. is accordingly disposed of.
