12. This matter is taken up through Hybrid arrangement (video conferencing/physical mode).

This is an application for extension of interim bail order dated 07.10.2024 passed in I.A. No.1817 of 2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though the petitioner was released on interim bail on the ground of ailment of his wife, but after being released on bail, he could not arrange money for treatment of his wife and his wife's health



condition is deteriorating day by day and therefore, the interim bail order dated 07.10.2024 may be extended for some period.

Learned counsel for the State, on the other hand, opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the respective parties and the averments taken in the interim, we are inclined to extend the bail order dated 07.10.2024 passed in I.A. No.1817 of 2024 till 24.11.2024.

The petitioner shall surrender on 25.11.2024.

It is made clear that if the petitioner does not surrender on the date fixed, the learned trial Court is at liberty to take coercive steps against the petitioner in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the I.A. stands disposed of.
