1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
 2. Petitioner in this writ petition seeks to assail the order dated 20.04.2024 passed by Additional Tahasildar, Nischintakoili in Suo Motu Bebandobast Case No.40 of 2016.
 3. At the outset, Mr. Nayak, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has a remedy under the relevant Government Resolution to file Appeal, if he feels aggrieved by the order in a bebandobast case. Hence, he prays for withdrawal of the writ petition to avail such remedy.
 4. Mr. Dash, learned Additional Standing Counsel does not have any objection to such prayer.
 5. In view of the submission made by the learned Counsel for the Petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with an observation that the Petitioner, if so



advised, may avail the remedy of Appeal under the relevant Government Resolution.
