01. 1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant petition under Section 482 BNSS is filed seeking pre-arrest bail of the petitioner in connection with G.R. Case No.1744 of 2025 pending in the file of learned S.D.J.M., Bolangir arising out of Bolangir Town P.S. case No.659 of 2025 on the grounds stated therein.
3. From the FIR as at Annexure-1, this Court finds that the petitioners found slaughtering a calf and managed to flee from the spot on arrival of the members of Bajrang Dal. Apart from the petitioners, some other accused persons are also allegedly involved in the incident as further revealed. It is informed to the Court that the principal accused, namely, Abani Nanda named in the FIR has been released on bail by the order of the learned court below and the petitioners do not have any similar antecedent as informed to the Court by the learned counsel



appearing for them. Recorded the objection of the State and having regard being the above facts, the petitioners, who apprehend arrest by the local police should be directed to be released on bail upon their surrender before the court of learned S.D.J.M., Bolangir with suitable conditions imposed even though they are not entitled to pre-arrest bail as has been pleaded for.

4. Accordingly, it is ordered.

5. In the result, the ABLAPL is disposed of with the direction as aforesaid. In the event, the petitioners surrender before the court of learned S.D.J.M., Bolangir within a fortnight from today, they shall be released on bail in connection with G.R. Case No.1744 of 2025 corresponding to Bolangir Town P.S. case No.659 of 2025 upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs.30,000/-(rupees thirty thousand) each with one solvent surety for the like amount each with such other conditions imposed by the court concerned as deemed just and proper and in the facts and circumstances of the case besides the following, such as, they shall not be involved in such nefarious activities after being released on bail.
