1. As per the office note, the postal A.D. on limitation has been received back from opposite party Nos.6 & 15 after valid service. No one appears for the said opposite parties, hence, the notice against them is treated as sufficient. Furthermore, unserved notices have returned from opposite party Nos. 1 & 2, 10 to 13 & 16, hence, therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to take fresh steps for issuance of notices to them. In so far as notice vis-à-vis opposite party No.14 is concerned, it has also been received back with a postal remark 'deceased' and in view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, no substitution is directed since the LRs are already on record as opposite party Nos. 15 & 16. However, in respect of opposite party No.17, steps are to be taken forthwith. As regards



opposite party Nos. 3,4,18 to 28 the postal tracking reports as at flag-‘B’ reveal the notices to have been delivered on them, though, the Court has not received back the unserved notices. In view of the postal reports, notices against the said opposite parties is also held as sufficient.
