1. Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
2. Instant I.A. is filed seeking extension of time granting a further period of three months to the opposite party to deposit the fine and also the compensation directed in view of the judgment in the CRLREV dated 23rd March, 2026.
3. This Court directed the opposite party to make the deposit within a stipulated period. Recorded the objection of learned counsel for the opposite party (complainant). It is submitted to the Court that the opposite party is unable to arrange the money to deposit the fine and also the compensation. It is submitted to the Court that the opposite party deposited an amount of Rs.6 lac at the time of his release before the learned court below. This Court in view of the difficulty expressed by the opposite party in complying the payments in view of the judgment in CRLREV and with the



petitioner's objection noted down allows extension of time by forty days to commence from today.
