SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 19.12.2024 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-34712-2024.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in compliance of the above referred to order, speaking order dated 08.05.2026 has been passed. The same is taken on record, copy whereof has also been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.
3. A perusal of the speaking order dated 08.05.2026 that order dated 19.12.2024 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-34712-2024 has been duly complied with.
