SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail, filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of 'the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023' in a case arising out of FIR No.22 dated 11.02.2025, for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.
2. Vide order dated 02.02.2026, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order dated 02.02.2026, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. The learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that in view of above, the order dated 02.02.2026 be made absolute.
4. On the instructions of Inspector Manpreet Singh, the learned State



Counsel has submitted that in compliance with the order dated 02.02.2026, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 09.02.2026, and that for further investigation of this case custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

5. In view of above, the order dated 02.02.2026, whereby interim anticipatory bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

6. Present petition stands allowed, accordingly.
