The aforesaid petition was filed on 29.1.2026 by Mr. Mudit Johar, Advocate. However, certain objections were raised by the Registry on 02.2.2026.

As per Rule 9, Chapter I, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition, on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel party, who filed it, to re-file within a period of 40 days.
