Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 26.06.2025 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Superintending Canal Officer, Bhakra Water Service Circle, Sirsa; order dated 27.01.2025 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Divisional Canal Officer, Sirsa Water Services Division; and order dated 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Sub Divisional Canal Officer, Panjuana Water Services, Sub Division Sirsa.
