1. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 18.08.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Writ Court in CWP-1745-2001, titled as 'Mohinder Pal Galhotra vs. Punjab State Electricity Board, Patiala and others' whereby the writ petition was allowed and it was further directed that "notional seniority and promotion be granted to the petitioners with all consequential benefits from the date their juniors were promoted. Accordingly, their pension be refixed within 3 months".

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Ms. Aprajita, Pension Branch, submits that in compliance of the Writ Court order, seniority has already been granted to the petitioner. It is further undertaken that all consequential benefits shall be released to the petitioner by 30.04.2026.



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the undertaking of the respondent, the present contempt petition be disposed of.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Rule stands discharged.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
