3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurdaspur and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurdaspur has submitted copy of report dated



20.02.2026 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052** and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, this petition is allowed and FIR No. 54 dated 18.10.2024 under Sections 333, 351(2), 324(4), 238 and 3(5) BNS registered at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of compromise.
