The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita with a prayer to grant of anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.334 dated 11.12.2025, under Sections 420, 409, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

2. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 17.02.2026 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully co-operated with the Investigating Officer in the present case. He further submits that the petitioner has also deposited an amount of Rs.15,36,000/-



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with the trial Court, as directed by this Court vide the order dated 17.02.2026.

3. Learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 17.02.2026 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
