1. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as far as petitioner no.1 is concerned, the order of the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has been complied with. It is submitted that as far as petitioner no.2 is concerned, although petitioner no.2 has been regularized but monetary benefits have not been given, although the order of the Co-ordinate Bench is dated 08.10.2025

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Vikas Gupta, SDO, Public Health, Karnal, has submitted that the monetary benefits to which the petitioner no.2 is entitled would be released to him within a period of 2 months from today. It has further been submitted that in case the same is not done and the petitioners are required to revive the present contempt petition,



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then, the respondents would pay an amount of Rs.15,000/- as litigation expenses.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the same, the present petition be disposed of but the respondents be bound by the statement made before this Court and further liberty be granted to the petitioners to revive the case in case the respondents back track from the statement made before this Court.

4. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of. Respondents are bound down by the statement made before this Court. Liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition in case the respondents back track from the statement made before this Court.
