The instant petition has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s) in case bearing FIR No. 229 dated 29.11.2025 for offence(s) under Sections 109, 118(1), 115(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 118(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 added later on, registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

2. Vakalatnama on behalf of the complainant has been filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) *inter alia* contends that pursuant to the order dated 10.02.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required for investigation of the case.



4. Learned State counsel on instruction from the Investigating Officer, corroborates the said averment and submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required for the purpose of investigation.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. Since the petitioner(s) have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is ***allowed*** and the interim order dated 10.02.2026 is made absolute.
