1. This petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (hereinafter referred to as 'BNSS'), has been filed for anticipatory bail, in a case arising out of FIR No.105 dated 22.07.2025 under Sections 21, 27(a), 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

2. Vide order dated 13.02.2026 the petitioner(s) was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. It was also directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner(s) that in compliance with order dated 13.02.2026, the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation.



4. The learned State Counsel has submitted that the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and for further investigation of this case his custodial interrogation is not required.
