**NIDHI GUPTA J. (Oral)**

Present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of orders dated 07.5.2025 (Annexure P-1); 28.7.2025 (Annexure P-2); and 28.10.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRR(F)-684-2025 titled as “Gurwinder Singh vs. Khushvir Kaur”, whereby the respondent-husband therein was directed to pay Rs.25,000/- to the petitioner-wife in compliance of the order dated 07.5.2025 (Annexure P-1).

At the very outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the dispute involved in the present contempt petition pertains to payment of an amount of Rs.25,000/- only.



Today, learned counsel for the respondent has handed over in Court a copy of Demand Draft No. 500821 dated 13.03.2026 for an amount of Rs.25,000/- drawn in favour of the petitioner-wife at ICICI Bank. The said copy bears endorsement of receipt by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner-wife. The same is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid development, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that since the amount directed by this Court has now been paid and compliance of the order stands effected, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and may accordingly be disposed of.

This Court has considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties. Since the substantive direction forming basis of the present contempt proceedings has admittedly been complied with, no further cause survives for adjudication in the present petition.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition is **disposed of** as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
