1. This revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the learned Trial Court, Jind to expedite and conclude the proceedings in case bearing No. 646-2019 titled Ramphal etc. Vs. Paramvir Singh etc., which is pending before the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Jind, within a time-bound period.

2. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, issuance of notice to the respondents is dispensed with, as it would only delay the proceedings and cause unnecessary expenditure to the respondents.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the material on record.



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4. Case of petitioners is that petitioners had instituted a civil suit for recovery of Rs.39,37,000/- on 21.08.2019. Notice was issued on 25.09.2019 and after multiple adjournments including those due to the COVID-19 pandemic on 23.03.2020, 01.07.2020, 19.10.2020, 01.12.2020 and 19.04.2021, the defendants filed their written statement on 02.09.2021 after availing as many as 11 opportunities. Thereafter, replication was filed and issues were framed on 25.11.2021. An application for reframing of issues was moved on 13.10.2022, which was eventually allowed on 04.09.2023. The plaintiff's evidence was concluded on 23.11.2023. It is further submitted that the proceedings were stayed or adjourned in compliance with orders passed by this Court in CR-7714-2023 from 15.01.2024 until 01.05.2025, when the revision was rendered infructuous. On 11.09.2025, the defendants produced evidence and moved applications for taking the voice sample of petitioner No.1 and for admission and denial. After filing of replies on 14.10.2025, the case was adjourned for consideration on said applications to 12.01.2026 and subsequently to 17.03.2026. It is submitted that the suit is pending for more than 6 years, causing great hardship to the petitioners.

5. This Court cannot lose sight of the fact that the suit was filed in the year 2019 and the trial has not been concluded despite the passage of significant time. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of and the trial Court is directed not to unnecessarily adjourn the case and make sincere efforts to dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible.



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6. Pending misc application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
