1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to pay gratuity amounting to Rs.12,60,500/- and interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payment from 01.03.2021 till the date of payment as allowed vide gratuity pay order dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) and revised gratuity pay order dated 23.01.2024 (Annexure P-5), to pay commutation of Rs.4,44,836/- to the petitioner immediately as allowed vide commutation value order dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-6) and also to pay interest @ 18% per annum on account of difference in arrears of pension amounting to Rs.4,42,000/- on account of delayed payment.

2. Despite the case having been called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that neither the petitioner nor his counsel is interested in pursuing the present petition.



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3. Under these circumstances, having left with no other option, the present petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution accordingly.
