On 06.03.2026, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 is for setting aside the impugned order dated 23.12.2025 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Panchkula in case FIR No.100 dated 21.08.2025 under Sections 75, 66, 66C & 66D of IT Act, 2008 and Sections 318(4) & 61 of BNS, 2023 (Sections 420 and 120-B IPC) and Section 42(3) of the Telecommunications Act, 2023 registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, District Panchkula whereby the bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner are cancelled and forfeited to the State and warrants of arrest have been issued against him and notice to his surety has also been issued.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of illness of his mother, the petitioner was unable to appear on 23.12.2025 on which date the impugned order (Annexure P-2) came to be passed. She states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Society for the Care of Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh Account No.10506615304, IFSC Code:- SBIN0003246, MICR Code:160002014, State Bank of India, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.



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A copy of the receipt depositing a sum of Rs.25,000/- with the aforesaid Society as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner be produced in the Court on the next date of hearing.

A copy of the receipt depositing a sum of Rs.25,000/- with the aforesaid Association as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner be produced in the Court on the next date of hearing.”

In deference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has been granted the concession of interim bail vide order dated 13.03.2026 passed by the CJ(SD)/RC/ACJM, Panchkula. A copy of the said order is taken on record and marked as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from the Trial without sufficient cause.
