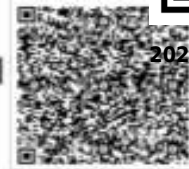

The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 (Section 438 Cr.P.C.) in case bearing FIR No.150 dated 15.09.2025 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 191 and 192 IPC registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.05.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

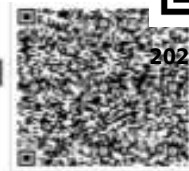
The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 04.05.2026 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
