1. The petitioners through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to take strict action against the private respondents for violating standard protocols prescribed for drawing blood samples.

2. On 27.02.2026, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioners have levelled allegations against respondents No.7 and 8 by stating that blood samples were collected from petitioners by reusing a syringe. Counsel asserts that few days later, petitioners were found to be infected with HCV (Hepatitis-C Virus). She asserts that petitioners have given complaints, Annexure P-2 and P-3, to the police authorities and a representation dated 30.01.2026, Annexure P-4, to the Chief Medical Officer, Nawanshahr, which are not being looked into.

Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Siddharth Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance on behalf of the

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respondents No.1, 4 to 6. He requests for deferment to get instructions and file a response.

List on 21.04.2026.

Let the aforesaid respondents refer the matter to the Medical Negligence Committee, which shall go into the allegation and submit a report on or before the next date.”

3. Learned State counsel during the course of hearing produced report prepared by a Committee of Doctors which has found no fault on the part of respondents No.7 & 8.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners may be permitted to avail remedy as permissible by law.

5. Disposed of with aforesaid liberty.
